### CSSE 11+ examinations

At Parents Evening, a number of Y4 and Y5 parents were asking about the 11+ examination and how well the children are being prepared through the 11+ Pod.

As a school, we recognise that the 11+ is an important part of many children's development as they prepare for secondary school, and potentially at a Grammar School. We work with Simone Foley at <u>11+</u> <u>Pod</u> who offers an 11 + Club at Bournes Green to help our children prepare for the CSSE 11+ examination. The sessions are led by experienced teachers and closely follow the curriculum requirements required to be successful when taking the exam. In their sessions, they will teach and develop skills in Maths, English (comprehension & writing) & Applied Reasoning.
