

### Bournes Green Book Week

Thank you so much for your support and contribution towards what has been a fantastic book week. This was much more than today's dressing up as your favourite book character, and the children have enjoyed the events and activities primarily aimed at raising the profile of reading and how much fun it can be. Children learning a love of reading at a young age is so important to their future success and this starts with the adults around them. We have had a great week including book sales and a brilliant visit from star local author, Ellie Irving. The week culminated in today's World Book Day celebrations. We had some fantastic literary costumes from children and staff, which was great to see. Below is a taster of some of the activities we offered:

- Read anytime, anywhere: in the lead up to World Book Day, children and staff were encouraged to take photos of themselves reading in interesting places and share it with the school. Staff took photos with the book covering their face, leading to a great game of 'guess the reader' in our special WBD assembly.
- Secret reader: staff selected a story or longer extract they wanted to share with the children. Children then chose from a menu which they wanted to hear (without knowing which member of staff would be reading it). They then went to the appropriate place in the school to hear their selected story being shared.
- Drop Everything And Read (D.E.A.R.): At 11:40, everyone in both schools (children and staff) stopped whatever they were doing, picked up a book they would like to read and read it! This lasted for 15 minutes and was designed to send a message that reading for pleasure is important and something everyone should make time for!
