Their target is to raise enough money to sponsor three dogs for 2 years which is a minimum donation of £360. In order to achieve this, each class will be given a bucket next week and challenged with filling it with silver coins. The class with the heaviest bucket on Friday 22nd March will be rewarded with a new game for their wet play box.
